

NOAA Global Monitoring Division Foreign National Visitor Request Form

Foreign national guests (non-US) visiting a NOAA site for more than three days must complete the following procedure:

1) Please notify Julie Singewald **90 days** in advance of any foreign national visitation to a Global Monitoring Division (GMD) site.

PLEASE NOTE THAT VISITORS WITH A "GREEN CARD" DO NOT NEED TO COMPLETE THIS PROCESS.

- 2) Please send Julie via email a list of the computing systems any foreign nationals will access at GMD facilities.
- 3) If the foreign national will have access to the Research and Development High Performance Computing System, it is required to get prior approval from GFDL. Julie is responsible for gaining approval from GFDL. This adds processing time. Please allow an additional 2 weeks for this approval.
- 4) Julie will notify the foreign national what date they can enter the site. **Do not purchase airline tickets before receiving this information.**
- 5) Mandatory background investigations are performed for every foreign national who will be on site six months or longer. Background processing requires fingerprint cards, completing the OF-306, and a Security cover sheet. Julie can provide you with these forms.

Foreign nationals must be escorted by NOAA staff at all times at NOAA facilities. At GMD's observatories, escort must be coordinated with the observatory station chief.
